


Figure 2: Proportion of FNIM adults in London who have received <u>second dose</u> of COVID-19 vaccination over time in comparison to general London and Ontario population. Results from Our Health Counts London data linkage to ICES COVID-19 data.





Figure 3: Proportion of FNIM adults in London who have received <u>third dose</u> of COVID-19 vaccination over time in comparison to general London and Ontario population. Results from Our Health Counts London data linkage to ICES COVID-19 data.

Figure 3: RDS-II Adjusted Proportion of Indigenous adults who have received <u>first dose</u> of COVID-19, stratified by age






Figure 4: HCG Adjusted Proportion of Indigenous adults who have received <u>first dose</u> of COVID-19, stratified by sex

Figure 5: RDS-II Adjusted Proportion of Indigenous adults who have received <u>second dose</u> of COVID-19, stratified by age


Figure 6: HCG Adjusted Proportion of Indigenous adults who have received <u>second dose</u> of COVID-19, stratified by sex



Figure 6: HCG Adjusted Proportion of Indigenous adults who have received <u>fourth dose</u> of COVID-19, stratified by sex








